Entry fees: £9.00 per single round. Double rounds £15. County Juniors only £5 before closing date and £9 after.
For entries **received after** the closing date the fees are £12.00 single or £18.00 double.

No substitutions of archers or refunds of entry fees after closing date.

Closing date: Monday 26th October 2020. Target list and results will be posted on the HAA Website and sent via email.

Notes: Multiple entries subject to availability - **Only** the first round shot (regardless of bow class) will count for awards. If shooting 2 rounds you may be shooting on a different target for the second round. Would archers with physical impairments kindly state whether they wish to shoot from a wheelchair or stool and if they would wish to remain on the shooting line.

Conditions: GNAS dress regulations apply (rule 307). However, if it is cold just make sure you are warm. GNAS membership will be checked at signing in.

Photographers must register with the organiser on the day. No photographs may be taken without the permission of the organisers.

Please do not touch anyone else's equipment. This is NOT record status, therefore no equipment checks will be carried out.

Archers are expected to wear face covering when going to the bosses and scoring.

All score sheets will be signed and placed in a box and left for 72 hours before the results are compiled.

Lost arrows will be found by the archer who shot them and the field party only.

Archers will be asked to remove their target face and place it in a box at the end of their session.

If an archer uses the toilets then it is the archer's responsibility to wipe down the toilets after use.

There will be no other facilities available
