Junior Badge Scheme

Green 3 Dozen Arrows ver 50 (Longbow/Jelly bow) 75 (Recurve/Barebow) 100 (Compound) points at any distance and any target

White Any Score that gives an "Archer 3rd" class Classification

Black Any 4 dozen round that gives an "Archer 2nd" class classification

Blue Any 6 or 7 dozen round that gives an "Archer 1st" classification

Red Any 8 dozen round that gives a "Bowman 3rd class" Classification

Gold Any 9 dozen round that gives a "Bowman 2nd class" Classification

Purple Any 12 dozen round (UKRS) that gives a "Bowman 1st class" Classification or above

- 1 The scheme is open to all junior archers U18 affiliated to the Hertfordshire Archery Association.
- 2 Age group is determined by archeryGb rules of shooting at the time
- 3 An archer must shoot the qualifying score a minimum of three times for each badge
- 4 All scores can only be used once and must be shot in sequence.
- 5 All Scoring to be on official club headed score sheets or tournament score sheets in accordance with ArcheryGB rules of shooting.
- 6 An archer may not claim for a lower award than already achieved.
- 7 Archers may claim for a lower award at a higher age group if they wish (subject to note 4 above).
- 8 Purple awards are presented by the County President or Chairman.
- 9 All claims must be submitted to the County Junior Rep on the appropriate forms.
- 10 Only one badge may be claimed at a time. All badges are expected to be claimed as they are shot.
- 11 All Purple rounds must be shot at a UK record status tournament.
- 12 Purple award claims must be made within the same calendar year or within 3 months of the final qualifying score shot, whichever is the soonest.
- 13 The County Junior Representative must be informed of all awards no later than 2 months of the third score being shot by emailing juniors@hertsarchery.org.uk.
- 14 All Corresponding Metric scores are acceptable. Up to date score tables can be found on the ArcheryGB web site.
- 15 Classification scores are stated on archerygb.org.uk web site. Please make sure you use the correct age group, gender and bowstyle.
